The program, with its rigorous training in quantitative research methods and financial theory, leads to research spanning from corporate finance to behavioral finance, fintech innovation and entrepreneurship. A PhD in Finance leads to career opportunities in:

- Academia
- Policymaking organizations and think tanks
- Asset management, consulting, technology and other industries

As of 2023, the average newly hired assistant professor earned \$183,500 per year.¹

Admission is competitive, and students from all academic and cultural backgrounds are encouraged to apply.
