“ Effective corporations make significant investments in their emerging leaders. If we're going to address our nation's most critical issues, it's time for America's cities to do the same. ”

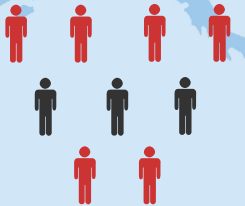

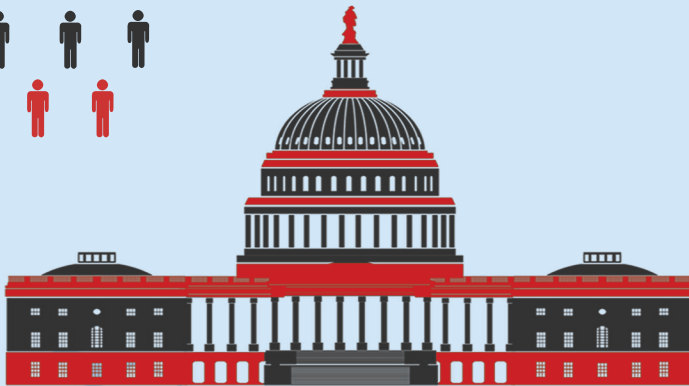
